

**MINUTES  
TOWN OF ANDREWS  
BOARD MEETING  
COMMUNITY SERVICES BUILDING  
FEBRUARY 13, 2007**

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Alderman Bristol, Alderman Adams, and Alderman Reid were present. Town Administrator Bill Green and Town Clerk Teresa Taylor were present. Also present was Town Attorney M. Ellen Davis. Alderman Jordan was not present at this meeting.

**ITEM 2**

Motion to approve the Agenda of February 13, 2007 by Alderman Reid. Second by Alderman Adams. Motion approved.

**ITEM 3**

Motion to approve the Minutes of January 09, 2007 as presented by Alderman Reid and Second by Alderman Adams. Motion carried.

**ITEM 4 – REPORTS**

Report by Bill Green that Phillip Gibson had purchased the surplus heater for \$150.00

**ITEM 5 – UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

None noted.

**ITEM 6 – NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Motion by Alderman Adams to approve Saturday March 17, 2007 for St. Patrick's Day Parade on Main Street at 2:00 PM. Second by Alderman Bristol. Motion carried.

- B. Next was a discussion to purchase new flags for Main Street. A motion was made by Alderman Bristol to purchase 14 flags at \$36.00 each for a total of \$504.00. Second by Alderman Adams. Motion carried.
- C. Next was a request from the Tax Collector for releases totaling \$531.48. Motion to approve by Alderman Reid. Second by Alderman Adams. Motion carried.
- D. Next was a discussion to establish April 10, 2007 as the hearing date for possible rezoning. This is to change the zoning from Highway Business to Central Business of Main Street East from Oak Street through Robbinsville Road. Motion to approve date by Alderman Bristol. Second by Alderman Reid. Motion carried.
- E. Next was a request for \$750.00 each for financial assistance for One Dozen Who Care, Cherokee County Food Bank, and for the Andrews Cultural Arts Center. Motion to approve by Alderman Bristol. Second by Alderman Reid. Motion approved.
- F. In public comment period Larry Dailey commended the Town of Andrews for the good job done at the Community Center. He said the counter tops look great and the repair work for the walkway is coming along. He requested that the Town please get the railroad crossing on Whitaker Lane repaired. Bill Green advised that he had spoken with Wesley Grindstaff at DOT about this issue and that engineering has been done and the road should be fixed when the asphalt plants open again in the spring. Larry also wants street signs on the new streetlights.

Tom Nash asks about the tattered North Carolina flags around town. Bill Green advised that the Town of Andrews has an agreement with the VFW to replace the flags that we will supply.

Gaitha McGaha ask for 3 speed bumps, children at play signs and for law enforcement to control parking issues at the Andrews Housing Authority. She was advised to speak with

her Resident Advisor (Lisa Rodriguez) to get on the Agenda for the next Andrews Housing Authority Board Meeting.

Eddie Adams requested to go ahead and advertise for the position of pool manager for this summer. He also reported that the Cherokee County Schools have agreed to help pay for the roofing at the Baseball field at Valley River Park. Ronnie Brooks also mentioned the lack of help from the schools on the maintenance of the baseball fields.

With no further business to come before the Board and upon motion by Alderman Reid the meeting was adjourned at 7:35 PM.
