

**MINUTES
TOWN OF ANDREWS
BOARD MEETING
COMMUNITY SERVICES BUILDING
APRIL 11, 2006**

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Members present were Alderman Bristol, Alderman Adams, and Alderman Jordan. Absent were Alderman Reid and Town Attorney M. Ellen Davis. Also present were Town Clerk Bill Green and Deputy Clerk Teresa Taylor.

ITEM 2

Upon Motion by Alderman Bristol and second by Alderman Adams, the Agenda was approved as submitted.

ITEM 3

Upon Motion by Alderman Adams and second by Alderman Bristol, the Minutes of the March 14, 2006 meeting were approved as presented.

ITEM 4 – REPORTS

The surplus police cars were awarded to a firm from Pennsylvania that deals in used police vehicles and were loaded up today for removal from the lot at Town Hall. The surplus vehicles brought \$3600 at bid. It was decided to hold another budget workshop on Thursday, April 20, 2006 at 5:30 pm at Town Hall to do more budget work on the 2006-2007 fiscal year budget.

ITEM 5 – OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business to consider at this time.

ITEM 6 – NEW BUSINESS

- A. First was a discussion of declaring more equipment rarely used by town Employees as surplus. After discussion with Town Employees, it was decided to declare the Ditchwitch purchased in 2000 as surplus equipment as well as the Great Dane walk-behind mower. Advertisements and offers to exchange these pieces of equipment as trade-in on new equipment to be made.

Motion to declare these two pieces of equipment as surplus by Alderman Bristol with a second by Alderman Adams. Motion carried.

- B. Next was a request from the Valleytown Cultural Arts group for financial assistance with their project to replace lighting in the main assembly area of the building. Motion by Alderman Adams to provide six hundred (\$600.00) dollars in assistance with this project. Second by Alderman Bristol. Motion carried.

- C. Next was a Motion by Alderman Jordan and second by Alderman Adams to declare April 20 and April 27, 2006 as Town cleanup days with Town crews picking up large objects not normally picked up by the Sanitation truck. The types of items allowed are old appliances, old tires and old furniture as well as other bulky items. Motion carried.

- D. Next was a request by the Andrews Chamber of commerce to declare Saturday, May 6, 2006 as Town Yard Sale Day and to request the closing of Main Street from Chestnut to Cherry Street for the purpose of holding the yard sale. Motion to declare May 6, 2006 as Town Yard Sale Day by Alderman Adams. Second by Alderman Jordan. Motion carried.

- E. Next was review of a proposed Ordinance passed to the Board of Aldermen by the Planning and Zoning Board dealing with Sexually Oriented Businesses. After a review of the paperwork presented by the Planning and Zoning Board, and upon Motion by Alderman Adams and second by Alderman Bristol, the date of May 9, 2006 was set aside for a public hearing on the proposed ordinance. Motion carried.

- F. Next under public comment, Tom Nash representing the Special Olympics group asked the Town of Andrews for One Hundred (\$100.00) in assistance to prepare a banner to be placed over Locust Street where the group will proceed to the Andrews High School site where the spring games will be held. Motion by Alderman Jordan and second by Alderman Bristol to provide the requested assistance. Motion carried.

Mr. Larry Dailey requested that street maintenance be performed on Hiwassee Street near his home to repairs the pot holes that were currently in the roadway. Mr. Dailey was assured that his street would be added to the list for repair work in the coming weeks.

With no further business to come before the Board and upon Motion by Alderman Adams, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
